Hills M2 Abbott Road Ramp Closures

16 July 2009

The Hills M2 Abbott Rd interchange will be shut overnight from 9.00pm until 5.00am for essential work over the next three weeks a spokesperson for the Hills M2 said today.

The spokesperson said the closures were required to replace the surface of the motorway ramps to ensure that the M2 maintains high standards of safety and provides a smoother ride for motorists.

“From Sunday 19 July to Tuesday 11 August, work will be undertaken at the Abbott Rd on and off ramps to the M2 motorway.

“As a consequence, access to and from the motorway in this area will be closed on most nights during this period.”

The spokesperson said the overnight closures of the ramps will be advertised via on road variable message signs (VMS) with up to date information about the status of the ramps available on the Hills M2 website at www.hillsm2.com.au

“Motorists who regularly use these ramps after 9pm are advised to plan ahead and work out the most appropriate alternative route from 19 July. The website will also provide maps of detour routes to assist motorists.”

The spokesperson said that every effort will be made to minimise the noise impacts on residents living adjacent to the work sites, however it was inevitable that there would be some level of disruption.

The management of Hills M2 apologise for any inconvenience caused during this time.
