## Hills M2 Pennant Hills Road Ramp Closure

23 July 2009

The Hills M2 Pennant Hills Rd eastbound exit will be shut overnight for two nights for essential maintenance a spokesperson for the Hills M2 said today.

The exit ramp will be closed (weather permitting) **on the evenings of Tuesday 28 July and Wednesday 29 July** from 9pm until 5 am the following morning.

The spokesperson said the closure was required to replace the surface of the motorway ramps to ensure that the M2 maintains high standards of safety and provides a smoother ride for vehicles.

“As a result, there is no access to Pennant Hills Road from the M2 for vehicles travelling eastbound during these times,” the spokesperson said.

The spokesperson said because of its seamless link to the Westlink M7, the Pennant Hills Eastbound off ramp on the M2 was part of North / South truck route and heavily utilised by trucks after 9pm.

“Anyone who uses this exit ramp after 9pm, in particular heavy vehicle operators, are advised to plan ahead and work out the most appropriate alternative route on these nights.

“The HillsM2 website will provide a detour route map to assist motorists to plan their journey.

“Overnight closures will be advertised via on road variable message signs (VMS) with up to date information about the status the work available at [www.hillsm2.com.au](http://www.hillsm2.com.au) .”

The spokesperson said that every effort will be made to minimise the noise impacts on residents living adjacent to the work sites, however it was inevitable that there would be some level of disruption.

The management of Hills M2 apologise for any inconvenience caused during this time.
