M2 Upgrade Roadworks and Lane Closures: 7-13 March

The following lane closures will be in effect on the Hills M2 for the week commencing Monday, 7 March to facilitate roadworks as part of the \$550 million Hills M2 Upgrade project.

In addition, there will be lane closures and contra-flow arrangements in the Norfolk Tunnel every night from Monday to Saturday for the life of the project.

Works this week include the installation of concrete barriers, traffic signs and temporary noise walls, the demolition of the Christie Road Bridge median and the installation of the Norfolk Tunnel noise curtain.

“Motorists are encouraged to plan their trip as work continues to upgrade the Hills M2 Motorway and changed speed limits are in place,” a project spokesman said

“The Hills M2 Motorway management apologise for the delays during construction and thank motorists for their patience.

“The project team will seek to minimise impacts; however, as the Hills M2 Upgrade is the largest project undertaken on an operational motorway in New South Wales, some delays can be expected over the two year construction period.”
