Hills M2 Upgrade Roadworks and Lane Closures: 25 Apr – 8 May

The following table shows lane closures that will be in effect on the Hills M2 from Monday 25 April until Sunday 8 May 2011 to facilitate roadworks as part of the \$550 million Upgrade Project.

In addition, other changed traffic conditions on local roads include:

- Christie Road Bridge: from 28 April, changed traffic conditions will be implemented including partial closure of one northbound lane. Two-way traffic will be maintained using the remaining existing two lanes.
- Murray Farm Road Bridge (also known as Kirkham Street Bridge): from 28 April, traffic across Murray Farm Road Bridge will be reduced to one lane until the bridge work is complete. Traffic signals will alternate the flow of traffic. Motorists can expect delays, particularly in peak periods. Signs will be in place to notify motorists of the changed conditions. Pedestrian and cyclist access will be maintained.
- Barclay Road Bridge: changed traffic conditions were implemented on 21 April. Two-way traffic will be maintained with one lane open in each direction.

There will be lane closures and contra-flow arrangements in the Norfolk Tunnel every night from Monday to Saturday for the life of the project.

Works over the coming fortnight include:

- Lift piling rig to bottom of Darling Mills Creek bridge
- demolition at Christie Road Bridge median
- works supporting the motorway control system
- erection of scaffolding at Beecroft Road bridge
- installation of temporary noise walls
- inspection of Terrys Creek underbridge (*Hills M2 maintenance work*)

“Motorists are reminded to plan their trip as work continues to upgrade the Hills M2 Motorway and changed speed limits are in place,” a project spokesperson said.

“The Hills M2 Motorway management apologise for the delays during construction and thank motorists for their patience.

“The project team will seek to minimise impacts; however, as the M2 Upgrade is the largest project undertaken on an operational motorway in New South Wales, delays can be expected over the two year construction period.”
